## Covid update

From the 20<sup>th</sup> July the restrictions on caring for children in “bubbles” was lifted and we have removed the temporary partitions in the rooms and children are able to play and mix with each other more freely. We will still keep the children in their own rooms and they will not mix with other age groups inside or outside. At the moment all other safety procedures such as regular cleaning, allocated drop off and pick up times and no visitors in the nursery will remain the same.

Our plan from September 2020 (as long as the government guidance allows) is to recommence our normal opening times of 7:30am – 6:30pm and to offer half day sessions again. We will also remove the allocated drop off and pick up times, although at this stage we are unsure whether parents will be able to enter the building during drop off and pick up times and you may still have to drop off at your child’s room door.

**Our nursery themes this month were:** Our Senses, On the Farm, Flowers & Trees, Four Seasons & Weather. The children have also enjoyed French, Yoga and Dance/Movement classes online. Pre-School phonics letters were T, N P and I and in French they have been practising counting through songs.
