Covid update

From the 20th July the restrictions on caring for children in “bubbles” was lifted and we are now able to return to our full capacity in terms of the number of children we care for. We have also removed the temporary partitions in the rooms and children are able to play and mix with each other more freely. We will still keep the children in their own rooms and they will not mix with other age groups inside or outside. At the moment all other safety procedures such as regular cleaning, allocated drop off and pick up times and no visitors in the nursery will remain the same.

Our plan from September 2020 (as long as the government guidance allows) is to recommence our normal opening times of 7:30am – 6:30pm and to offer half day sessions again. We will also remove the allocated drop off and pick up times, although at this stage we are unsure whether parents will be able to enter the building during drop off and pick up times and you may still have to drop off at your child’s room door.

Our nursery themes this month were: Our Senses, On the Farm, Flowers & Trees, Four Seasons & Weather. The children have also enjoyed French, Yoga and Dance/Movement classes online.



Beenies have enjoyed a variety of sensory experiences and learning about flowers.




Toddlers watered and tidied the flower displays, visited the local park and have enjoyed sensory games.
