- 23rd - St George's Day - children will take part in a variety of activities to celebrate this



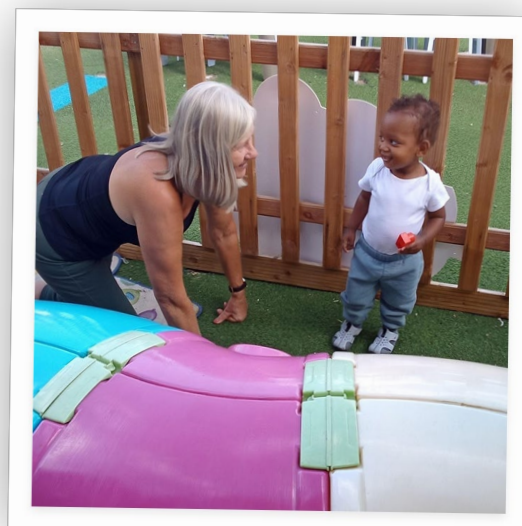


spare clothing
