If your child is going to be absent from the nursery, please ensure that you let the nursery know by 10am on the day as for safeguarding reasons we have to account for all absences.

suitable clothing

Please ensure your child comes to nursery with appropriate clothing for the weather. This includes warm layers and waterproofs during colder or wetter weather, and suitable, lightweight clothing and sun hats during warmer weather.

toys from home

Please remember that toys from home should not be brought into nursery. If your child does bring in a toy, it is not the responsibility of nursery staff to look after it, and there is a risk that it may become lost or damaged.

Funding forms have been sent out to all families claiming the Early Years Funding this term. If you have not already done so, please ensure that your completed forms are returned to nursery as soon as possible so we can process your funding correctly.
